### **History of the flight:**

- On September 30<sup>th</sup> , 2021 Airbus 320-214 aircraft registered SU-BPV operated by Air Cairo, flight no. MSC 2980 took off from Hurghada Airport (HEGN). It was En-route to Düsseldorf International Airport (EDDL) with 2/4 crew members and 127 Passengers on board.
- At FL360 and 89 NM from PETOV point Messages appeared on the ECAM (\*) Engine No. 1 stall.
- At 13:24 UTC the flight crew confirmed to Zagreb that they declared emergency (Engine No.1 Failure), the aircraft landed safely.

(\*) ECAM is a system on Airbus aircraft for monitoring and displaying engine and aircraft system information to the pilots. In the event of a malfunction it will display the fault and may also display the appropriate steps of the remedial action

- Readouts of all available data from flight data recorder were completed.
