

SUBPART 141L **Pilot Ground School Course**

TSH141L.1 Applicability

This standard prescribes the minimum curriculum for a pilot ground school course required under ECAR Part 141.

TSH141L.3 General requirements

An approved course of training for a pilot ground school must include training on the aeronautical knowledge areas that are:

- (a) Needed to safely exercise the privileges of the licence, rating, or authority for which the course is established; and
- (b) Conducted to develop competency, proficiency, resourcefulness, self-confidence, and self-reliance in each student.

TSH141L.5 Aeronautical knowledge training requirements

Each approved pilot ground school course must include:

- (a) The aeronautical knowledge training that is appropriate to the aircraft rating and pilot licence level for which the course applies; and
- (b) An adequate number of total aeronautical knowledge training hours appropriate to the aircraft rating and pilot license level for which the course applies.

TSH141L.7 Knowledge and skills test

Each person enrolled in a pilot ground school course must satisfactorily accomplish the knowledge and skills test, in accordance with the school's approved training course, consisting of the approved areas of operation that are appropriate to the operating privileges or authorization that graduation from the course will permit and for which the course applies.
